PRINT COMPETITION

1. TWO 11x14 print images, matted, mounted to foam core, and taken with a DSLR camera. Be sure these images reflect your <u>BEST</u> work.

Cell phone photos will be immediately disqualified!

2. Include a single-page, typed **Print Description** glued to the back of your first print submission and a single-page **resume** glued to the back of your second print submission.

(See second page for further details on layout and technical specs for above.)

WRITTEN EXAM

Students **must** pass a multiple choice test of photographic knowledge with **70% or higher**. The test will include questions on photographic history, exposure, lenses, camera parts, photoshop, and more.

FIELD ASSIGNMENT

A field assignment will be given **ONLY** to those who pass the above-mentioned exam. This assignment is an opportunity to showcase your camera **and** Photoshop skills.

- A. First Image will be captured in Manual mode and submitted in **RAW format**.
- B. Second Image will be edited per the instructions given and submitted in JPEG format.
- C. Label each image **CORRECTLY** per the instructions given, and save them to a USB.

The field assignment is due by 3:00 pm for final judging. NO EXCEPTIONS!

STATE CONTEST REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Provide two 11x14 prints mounted to 16x20 foam core backing.
- 2. Provide a resume and print description for evaluation with print submissions.
- 3. Pass a multiple-choice test **without** assistance.
- 4. Receive a field assignment from the event coordinator **AFTER** passing the written exam.
- 5. Use Manual Mode settings & capture RAW images for the field assignment.
- 6. Produce a creative image using Photoshop manipulation per assignment specifications.
- 7. Contestants may **not** disturb any other event in progress, enter restricted areas, interrupt conference functions, or participate in any behavior unbecoming to a national participant.

- DSLR camera with compatible lens(es)

PRINT COMPETITION SPECIFICATIONS



Submit 11x14 prints centered on 16x20 black foam core backing, with a hinged black over mat.

- A. 11x14 prints **MUST** be on **photographic paper**
- B. Each print **MUST** be mounted neatly to foam board (dry mounted preferred but not required)
- C. Each print MUST also have a black over mat
- D. Each print **MUST** have a label in the lower right corner as follows:

(YourContestantNumber)-Image(#): (Image Title)

Examples: 1465-Image1: Nebraska Sunset and

1465-Image2: Black Cat
