This Year's competition is all about being a productive member of your community. You will need to find a way to serve your community and document the entire process with audio and video. This will be a 60 second documentary. All captured media needs to be on a flash-drive.

Things you will need

- a 32GB Flash-drive. Label the drive with your name and school name.
- a computer to edit on with Adobe Premiere Pro.

Flash-drive can only contain the following before the start of the competition

- Recorded video
- Recorded audio

- Photos for the film

No copyrighted material can be used. Use of such material will result in disqualification. You can only use music and sound effects from the links above.

Requirements for the video.

- 1. Find a service that your Community needs.
- 2. Find a way that you can help with that need.
- 3. Layout your goals and what you hope to accomplish by serving your community.
- 4. Film and document the services you are providing.
- 5. Film and document the end result of the services that you provided.
- 6. Film and document whether or not the end result aligned with the goals that you initially set for this project.
- 7. You must take at least 10 photos in the process.

All filming and media gathering must be completed and placed on flash-drive by April 5th 2022.
